

URCA Mini Grant

Financial support for students chosen to present their work virtually at local or national conferences is available to UCSB undergraduates who have participated in either FRAP or URCA, regardless of major or college affiliation. The Undergraduate Research and Creative Activities Office offers mini grants (up to \$250) to help defray the cost of the conference fee or other out-of-pocket expenses (i.e. printing of materials, etc.). Funds for this purpose are limited and will be allocated on a first-come first-served basis. If approved, funding will be transferred to the mentor's department for distribution.

General Requirements

To be eligible for an URCA mini grant, the applicant must be in good academic standing, must be enrolled and maintain undergraduate status at UCSB when attending the conference, and must have participated or be participating in FRAP or URCA. Awards are for students participating in the conference, for example by presenting a paper or making a poster presentation. Attendance without participation will not be supported. Awards are not given retroactively.

The Following materials must be provided

- Mini Grant Informational Form
- Copy of the letter inviting you to present
- Information on the expected incurred costs for attending the conference
